Day #1 Monday July 25, 2011 Welcome to the "Great Land Alaska"

Our tour director meets us at the designated pickup points and transfers with us to Chicago O'Hare Airport for our flight to Fairbanks, Alaska. Upon arrival in Fairbanks, we transfer to our hotel and will be briefed on the upcoming days' itinerary. This evening you may wish to enjoy an Alaska Salmon Bake at Alaska Land with all the trimmings and an opportunity to explore the gold mine exhibits and shops after dinner. (subject to flight arrival time)

Day #2 Tuesday July 26, 2011 Delta Junction Agriculture, Farm Bureau Dinner

Our day is spent touring the Delta Junction area located southeast of Fairbanks, Alaska. This is the largest farming area in Alaska producing livestock, small grains, potatoes and a variety of wildlife farming programs. We'll visit with the Delta Junction Farm Bureau, tour farms, and enjoy a special get-together including dinner with farm families. We return to Fairbanks later this evening (D)

Day #3 Wednesday July 27, 2011**Gold Dredge, Pipe Line, Discovery Sternwheeler Cruise, LAR Research**

Today we'll visit the Alaska Pipeline and learn firsthand about this engineering achievement, visit the LAR (Large Animal Research) Center and view the Musk Ox facility. Enjoy a hearty lunch at Gold Dredge #8, and try your luck at panning for some gold nuggets. Next board the Discovery III Sternwheeler for a cruise on the Chena and Tanna Rivers. Visit an Indian village, watch a bush pilot perform short take off and landing, learn about fish wheels, dog sledding and much more. The evening is free to enjoy optional adventures in the area including a flight seeing trip over the Arctic Circle. (L)

Day #4 Thursday July 28, 2011 McKinley Rail, Denali Park Wildlife Tour

This morning, "All Aboard" as we travel on one of Holland America's luxury McKinley Explorer panoramic view domed rail cars to Denali Park. A (order off the menu) hearty breakfast will be prepared by the chef in our private dining car as we depart Fairbanks. Then, sit back and relax as our conductor narrates points of interest along the route. Upon arrival we check into our hotel with the balance of the evening to explore Alaska's largest city. (D on train)

Day #7 Sunday July 31, 2011 Welcome aboard the ms Zuiderdam

Today we travel south along Turnagain Arm made famous by Captain Cook's efforts to find the fabled NM Passage. Along the way we'll have an opportunity to view one of Alaska's most scenic areas along the Kenai Peninsula. Before arriving in Seward, Alaska a special visit is planned at the Trail Lakes Fish Hatchery to learn firsthand about the propagation and management of the fishing industry. Upon arrival in Seward, we proceed with embarkation and boarding our five star Holland America ms Zuiderdam. After checking into our deluxe stateroom, we will have time to become acquainted with all the amenities on our cruise ship. Our tour director will be available daily to meet with you regarding activities and assist with our special needs. (D)

Day #8 Monday August 1, 2011 Cruising, College Fjord

Day #10 Wednesday August 3, 2011 Port of call Haines/Skagway, Alaska

The Trail of "98" made this area of Alaska one of the most documented events of the Gold Rush days! We'll have an opportunity to visit the Bald Eagle Center and Fort Seward located in Haines, Alaska. In Skagway, Alaska learn about the infamous Soapy Smith, a notorious sort of Robin Hood outlaw and his final demise. Tour the museum of the gold rush, visit the shops and merchants of Skagway that are much the same as they were during those flamboyant days. Take a ride on the White Pass and Yukon Rail Road noted as one of the top ten rail adventures in North America! (BLD)

Day #11 Thursday August 4, 2011 Port of call/Juneau Alaska

Enjoy the day in Juneau, the capital of Alaska. There is an abundance of activities for us including sport fishing, Mt. Robinson Tram, Skagway flight seeing, historic city tour, capitol, governors mansion and wildlife tour to see marine life. For those interested we will visit the TaKu Cannery to talk with the fisherman and view the processing and packaging of Alaska Salmon (including sampling of their delicious smoked salmon). Be sure to check out The Red Garter Saloon! Shopping is easy in Juneau, with over a hundred stores and craft shops to choose from. (BLD)

Day #12 Friday August 5, 2011 Port of call/Ketchikan

Known as the "Salmon Capital of the World", Ketchikan has a colorful history as it was an all year open port and provided a trade and supply center for gold seekers, fishing, lumber and explorers alike. Today tourism and fishing are the two main industries. (BLD)

Day #13 Saturday August 6, 2011 Inside Passage Cruising

One last day to sit back, relax, and enjoy all the amenities of five star cruising aboard the ms Zuiderdam. A pool side get-together is planned this afternoon. (BLD)

Day #14 Sunday August 7, 2011 Vancouver and Home

We bid farewell to our Alaska adventure as we disembark our ship and transfer to the airport for our return flight home. (B)
