Day #1 - Saturday August 28, 2010

Tonight is free for viewing of the falls, enjoying the many cuisines offered in the Niagara area, or taking in a nightclub show or the casino! (B)

Day #4 - Tuesday August 31, 2010

This morning we travel the scenic shores of Lake Ontario to the very cosmopolitan city of Toronto. A local guide will join us for a **Toronto City Tour** including the historic district, theater and university area. Enjoy lunch (on our own) at one of the many bistros so popular with Toronto residents. This afternoon we'll visit **Casa Loma**, a true castle from the estate of the late Sir Henry Pellatt, a prominent financier in Toronto's golden days. Visit the gardens, coach house and main living quarters of the Pellatt family. There will be free time for exploring the quaint shops and boutiques of this cosmopolitan city before a delightful dinner at a local restaurant in Toronto. Upon our return to Niagara Falls, enjoy the many activities available. (B,D)

Day #5 - Wednesday September 1, 2010

After a hearty continental breakfast we check out of our hotel and bid farewell to Niagara Falls as we travel through U.S. customs. Welcome to Michigan and a visit to one of the oldest wineries in the state of Michigan. The **St. Julian Estate Winery** is internationally noted for their crafted wines and unique tastes. We will enjoy tasting of their premium wines and also the opportunity to select their products to take with us. We arrive at our hotel in Marshall, Michigan with time to freshen up. Tonight we enjoy great food and entertainment at the popular **Cornwall's Dinner Theater**. (B,D)

Day #6 - Thursday September 2, 2010

This morning we visit the **Treemendous Fruit Farm Market**, home to the world champion cherry pit spitting contest. We will have a representative from Treemendous Fruit Farm give us an overview of this extensive orchard operation. There will be time to stroll through this amazing market and purchase quality fruits, preserves and cheeses to take home. We will arrive home in the late afternoon. **(B)**
